

## Working out the number of children with SLCN in your setting

1. How many children do you have on roll?
  - a. Work out 10% of this figure. 10% of children have long term SLCN.
  - b. Work out how many children are likely have delayed language.\*

*\*If your setting is in an area of deprivation up to 50% of children could have delayed language and other identified SLCN.*

2. Use your SEND register to find out how many children are identified as having SLCN.

Is this different to the 10% figure you worked out above? By how much? This is the number of children with SLCN who your setting may be missing.

### Worked Example (this is not a real setting!)

**Number of children in Chatterbox nursery 58**

**Number of pupils with SLCN: 6**

*Chatterbox nursery is in an area of disadvantage*

**Number of pupils likely to have delayed language: 29**

**Number reported as having SLCN on SEN register: 1**

**Therefore, the number who are 'missed' is at least: 5 (6-1)**
